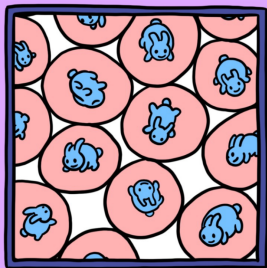


Weeee... oh... hello.

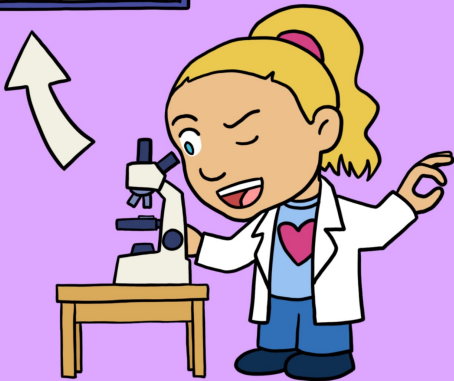


My name is Jane.

my story about cancer?

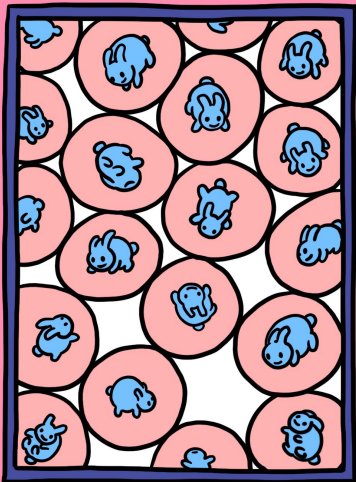




My body, just like yours is made of lots of tiny little things called cells.

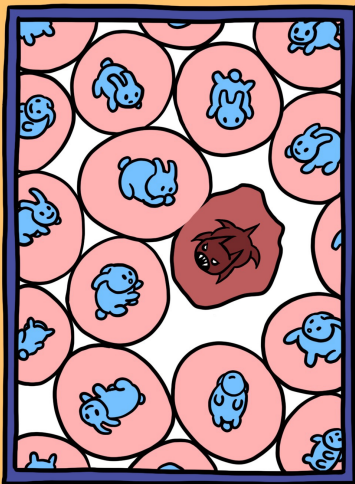


Cells help us do everything like running and jumping and breathing and thinking.



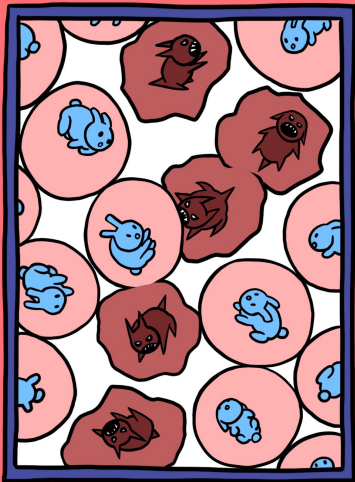
One day, when a cell was making a new cell there was a mistake.

The new cell was bad.

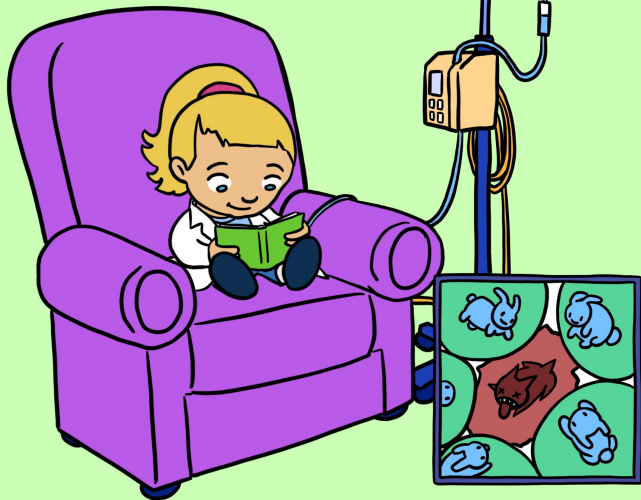


The bad cell made lots of other bad cells and kept growing, this is cancer.

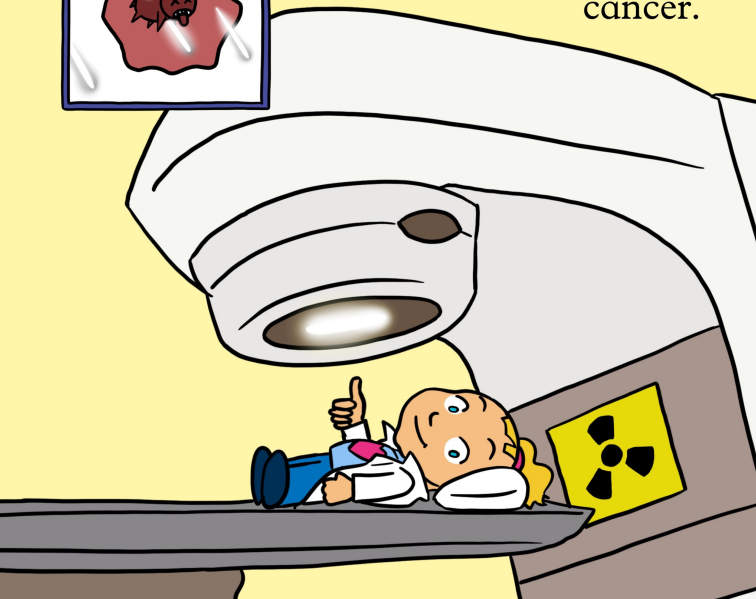
What can we do about this?



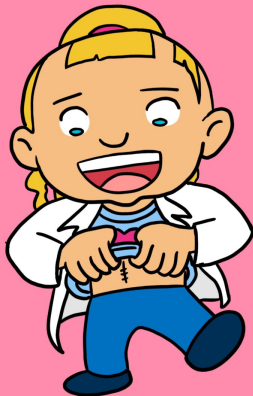
Sometimes we can

made that fight cancer.



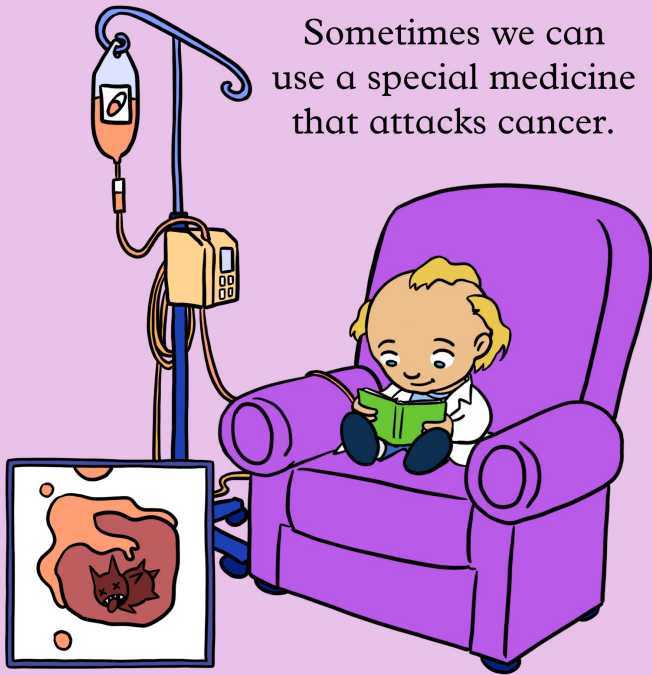
Sometimes we can use a special beam that shoots cancer.



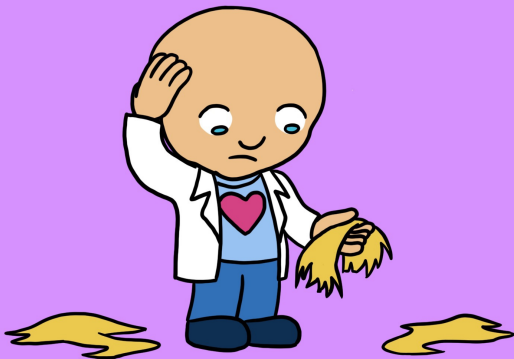
Sometimes a doctor can cut

makes my hair fall out.



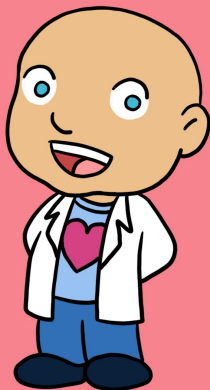
The special medicine also  
makes me do lots of vomits.



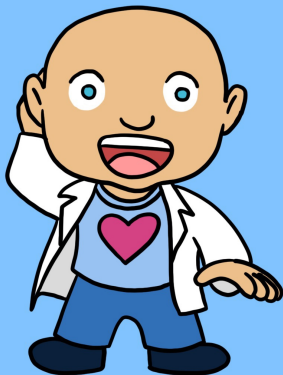
I have to wash my hands

get very sick if I don't.



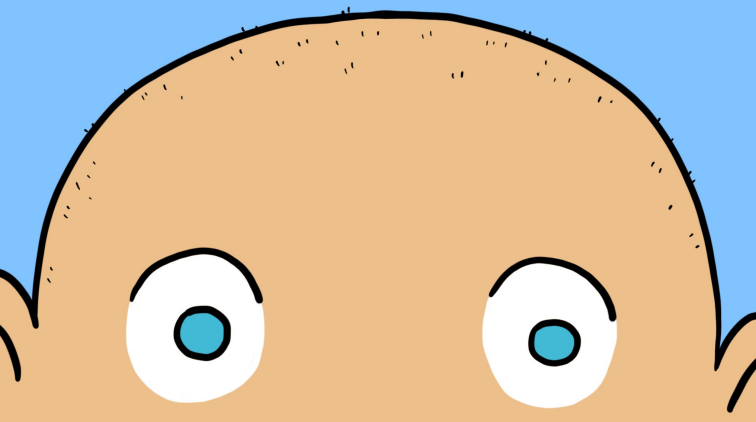
That was my cancer story,
